I am using a 56K modern which seems to work fine. I can get the modern working and I am told (by the icon on my taskbar) that I am connecting at speeds of 57600. I get such wildly different speeds when I download files (anything from 180 bytes/sec to 6.0K/sec) that I am starting to feel as though I have set the modem up incorrectly. What exactly does 56K mean? Does it mean that I can transfer files at a 'theoretical' speed of 56K/sec? I do understand the difference that traffic can make, and I have read around in magazines, but still feel unsure what kind of transfer rates to expect. Please help. Nigel Whyte

There are many factors to consider when talking about the connection rate and download speed through an analogue (telephone) line. The overall speed of a connection over the Internet will only be as fast as the connecting to. For example, if you live in the UK and you are accessing a US site to download a file, the data will pass through a number of hops or routers in the path at that moment
